



Perfect Chinese Landscape INS-CN17

Ancient scrolls of Chinese landscape paintings of high mountains, ancient pines, bizarre rocks, and seas of clouds come alive at Huangshan Mountain in southern Anhui Province. Recently listed on UNESCO's World Cultural and Natural Heritage List. As beautiful as Huangshan Mountain is, there is much more to offer visitors than just the mountain. Nearby Huangshan, and the ancient villages of Hongcun and Xidi are not to be missed sites on anyone's itinerary to China. The ancient villages of Hongcun and Xidi have both been listed on UNESCO's World Cultural Heritage List. Most note worthy is the way that these two villages has been beautifully preserved offering visitors a glimpse into what China was like during the late Qing Dynasty.

Day 1: Arrive Tunxi (-)

Arriving Tunxi where you will be taken to your hotel at the foot of Yellow Mountain.

Day 2: Huangshan (B)

You'll drive to Huangshan. Ascend by cable car arrive White Goose Ridge and hike about 40 minutes to your hotel at the peak of Huangshan for an extraordinary perspective of the surrounds. We spend the afternoon hiking on the ridges of Huangshan. Enjoy sunset from the Cloud Dispelling Pavilion. Overnight at Huangshan.

Day 3: Huangshan (B)

Morning free at leisure; try to get up early in the morning to catch the Huangshan Mountain's magnificent sunrise. After breakfast you can tour the Begin-to-Believe Peak, where you will see its ancient twisted pines. The clouds and mist clinging to the peaks are ever changing making the many peaks appear like small islands in a sea of clouds. After all the exercise, you will take the cable car down the mountain where your driver will be waiting to take you back to Tunxi. Overnight at the foot of Yellow Mountain.

Day 4: Depart Tunxi (B)

Before leaving for the airport visiting Hongcun and Xidi. With a history of over 900 years, Xidi Village is segmented by over 40 ancient winding and narrow lanes which are paved with bluestones, passing through countless aged and narrow alleys. Afternoon drive to airport for your onward flight.

Inclusions:
